Welcome!

The guesthouse is not a place freely open to the public. It is a family that welcomes you into their home. This is why we invite you to enjoy all the living spaces at your disposal in a friendly atmosphere and with respect for the privacy of each person.

Arrivals :

In order to be able to welcome you in the best possible conditions, your welcome will be made from 4pm on the day of your arrival until 8pm. Late or early arrivals, for example, to drop off luggage in order to visit the neighbourhood with a less vulnerable vehicle, are subject to prior agreement.

Departures :

On the last day, departures are no later than 11am. We are not hotel professionals, we must have enough time to offer the most welcoming accommodation to those arriving afterwards.

Breakfasts :

Breakfasts are served inside or outside the house if the weather permits, between 8:00 am and 10:00 am.

Accommodation:

The rooms are not intended for washing clothes or taking meals .

Shower gels, shampoo, body cream, slippers...are at your disposal for your comfort. Please do not take them with you, they will also be useful for those who will follow you.

Visitors can also access Wifi for free. Illegal downloading is forbidden. The customer will be responsible for any heavy soiling. Valuables (jewellery, multimedia devices, various means of payment, etc.) must not be left in the rooms or in parked vehicles. Guests decline all responsibility in case of disappearance of these objects.

General provisions :

In compliance with decree N°2006-1386 of 15 November 2006, smoking is forbidden in public places. The entire establishment, including the rooms, is therefore non-smoking. Within the framework of the protection of minors, the sale of alcohol is forbidden to minors under 18 years of age.

Guests must respect the peaceful nature of the premises and use them for their intended purpose. The client undertakes to return the rooms in the state in which he found them at the end of the stay (vacuum cleaner and cleaning products are available), to leave all the objects present in the room and to declare and take financial responsibility for any possible damage for which he could be responsible.

Children living in the property are under the sole responsibility of their parents. Only those who have booked are allowed to enter the premises. Theft and accidents: the owner declines all responsibility in the event of theft or bodily injury occurring on the property.
